


We are proud that the vision of this international competition is developing musical culture and art and providing young people with the opportunity to measure the value of their work through competition.

JURY MEMBERS

PERCUSSION





Critics have given the internationally renowned marimba virtuoso and chamber musician **Katarzyna Myćka** the sobriquet "she who dances with the mallets". Her "perfect mallet technique" and "marvelous, rhythmic precision" are characteristic for the musician, who performs on a beautiful five-octave concert marimba.

Expert circles testify to the "extraordinary richness of tone quality" and "fascinatingly broad palette of musical effects" of the marimba, which is rarely heard as a solo instrument. Audiences are also enthralled by the artistic elegance and dance-like energy of her playing.

After receiving training in piano and percussion, she discovered the marimba as her "ideal medium for musical expression" while studying at music academies in Gdańsk, Stuttgart, and Salzburg. Numerous prizes and awards at international music competitions then followed: in 1995, first prize and audience prize at the International Percussion Competition Luxembourg for Marimba Solo, one year later first place at the first World Marimba Competition Stuttgart. Invitations to give concerts and master classes in America, Asia, and various European countries followed naturally.

Appearances as a soloist at the most important marimba festivals and events (Osaka, 1998; Linz, 2004; Minneapolis, 2010; various editions of PASIC in the USA) as well as solo parts with well-known orchestras around the world (Stuttgart Philharmonic Orchestra, Bochum Symphony, Polish Chamber Philharmonic Sopot, Vienna, Prague and Heilbronn Chamber Orchestras (WKO), Beijing Symphony Orchestra, Camerata Israeli, RSO Luxemburg and many others) today make Katarzyna Myćka one of the leading pioneers in her still-evolving instrument.

The large concert marimba has only existed in its current form since the mid-1980s. Myćka, who was honored by the Polish Percussive Arts Society in 1999 as "Ambassador of Polish Percussion Art", emphatically promotes the popularization of the marimba. For her, this includes a commitment to training young players and participation in juries at international competitions, but in particular the International Katarzyna Myćka Marimba Academy

(IKMMA), which she established in 2003. The 10th edition in 2023 consolidated 20 years of history connecting people through love to marimba, music and friendship. This same year, Katarzyna Myćka was appointed as professor for percussion at the Folkwang University of Arts in Essen, Germany, while she continues her educational work at the Stanisław Moniuszko Music Academy in Gdańsk, Poland.

Katarzyna Myćka dedicates "a lot of time and enthusiasm" to collaborating with composers who "explore and understand the special and marvelous sound of the marimba." In this, the guiding principle —says the musician, to whom numerous concerts and chamber music works have been dedicated—is "musical trust."

The artist's multifaceted solo program includes not only transcriptions of the works of Johann Sebastian Bach or Sergei Prokofiev, but also original compositions by coetaneous composers such as Emmanuel Séjourné or Anna Ignatowicz-Glińska. Over the years, she has recorded a cross-section of her repertoire on ten CDs. Her most recent album, "Marimba & Organ Melange", includes yet another collection of premiere recordings.



The Austrian multi-percussionist **David Christopher Panzl** was born in Salzburg and began his percussion training at the age of four under the tutelage Martin Grubinger senior. He performed his first solo concerto at the age of 13 with the Reichenhall Philharmonic Orchestra. During his school days he travelled to New York several times in order to study jazz.

Panzl then moved to Vienna to complete his studies as a concert percussionist with Professor Josef Gumpinger at the Conservatory of Vienna Private University, where he then completed his Master of Arts degree with top honours in 2013, studying with Anton Mittermayr. Lastly, he studied Marimba in Tokyo at the Toho Gakuen School of Music under Keiko Abe.


He is currently lecturer for concert percussion at the University for Music and Performing Arts in Vienna.

Concert opportunities developed with such orchestras as the Radio Symphony Orchestra of Vienna, the orchestra of the Vienna State Opera, the Mozarteum-Orchester Salzburg and the Konzerthaus Orchester Berlin.

As a soloist David Christopher Panzl has performed at the Suntory Hall Tokyo, the Seoul Art Center, the Vienna Konzerthaus and at the opening festivities of the Salzburg Music Festival. He has collaborated with exceptional artists such as Keiko Abe, Nebojsa Zivkovic, Jeff Queen, Tim Collins and HK Gruber. In addition, he also has performed solo concertos with the Nürnberg Symphony Orchestra, Innsbruck Symphony, Reichenhall Philharmonic Orchestra, the Sarajevo Philharmonic Orchestra, the Symphonic Wind Orchestra of Salzburg and the German Chamber Orchestra Berlin. He has played world premieres of the composers Keiko Abe, Shih, Johannes Motschmann, Jorge Sanchez Chiong, Enjott Schneider and J. Peter Koene.

David C. Panzl judges in international competitions and leads master classes worldwide. His works are published by Doblinger Vienna and Pulsa Musica USA.

He appears with Paraty Records (Harmonia Mundi), Wergo (Schott Music) Edel Records Germany, endorses Yamaha, Zildjian, Vic Firth, Mike Balter and Loyal Drums.






Jože Bogolin was born in Brežice, Slovenia. His first steps in music began at Krško music school, later he studied at Music high school Ljubljana, Music Academy Ljubljana and finished with Master Degree at Hochschule für Theater und Musik München in the class of dr. prof. Peter Sadlo. During studies he achieved many different solo and chamber awards and compliments: TEMSIG – First Prizes and Special Prizes (2001, 2005, 2008), Povolletto, Italy – Second prize (2005), IPCL, Luxemburg – Second prize and Audience prize (2009), PENDIM, Bulgaria – First Prize (2009), Almere chamber music festival – Audience Prize (2011), Salieri – Zinetti competition – Third Prize and First Prize (2011, 2012).

He was playing and studying with many known musicians, such as Peter Sadlo, Keiko Abe, Momoko Kamiya, N. J. Živković, J. Beck, Peter Erskin, Bogdan Bacanu, Katarzyna Mycka, Mate Bekavac, Vladimir Askenazy, Marko Hatlak... Bogolin is also active as soloist and orchestra player. In his career he played with Australian Chamber, EUYO Orchestra, EUYO Wind Ensemble, RTV Slovenia Symphonic Orchestra, Filharmonia Salzburg, SNG Ljubljana and more.

Nowadays he is playing mainly as a chamber musician with DRUMARTICA – Slovenian percussion. Together with Simon Klavžar, Bogolin has performed in many important classical music venues in Serbia, Italy, Germany, Luxemburg, Russia, USA, China, Croatia, Spain, Canary Islands, Slovenia, Netherlands, Belgium and so on.

Currently, he works as professor on Konservatorij za glasbo in balet Ljubljana. In addition to his job, he is regular guest on modern music festivals, masterclasses and clinics home and abroad.

He is an endorser for ADAMS Musical instruments and Innovative Percussion Mallets.

Jure Gradišnik began his career in 2003 with a solo trumpet position in National Theatre of Opera and Ballet in Ljubljana, Slovenia. He went on to join Radio Symphony Orchestra as Principal Trumpet in 2010. In 2011 he was awarded the position of Trumpet Professor at the Ljubljana Academy of Music. He released "Rustiques", his first album in 2015 with his wife, harpist Maria Gamboz.

Jure is an active soloist and has appeared with many groups, including Symphony Orchestra of RTV Slovenia, Chamber Orchestra of the Slovene Philharmonic Orchestra, Filharmonie Oltenia from Romania, Chamber Orchestra of the Maribor Festival, SNG Opera and Ballet Ljubljana Orchestra, Slovak Chamber Orchestra-Cappella Istropolitana, Chamber Orchestra Philharmonia Oltenia, Orchestra Croatian Army and the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra.

As an orchestral musician he has performed with ensembles such as Australian Chamber, Slovenian Philharmonic, MittelEurope Orchestra, No Borders Orchestra and as chamber musician he is regularly playing with multiple chamber groups including SiBrass Quintet, Trio Seraphim and duo with harp.

Jure Gradišnik graduated from the Academy of Music in Ljubljana. Early in his career Jure won many European trumpet competitions, including the EU Yamaha Music Scholarship in 2003. In 2008 Jure was accepted at the prestigious Mozarteum in Salzburg, where he continued his studies with Professor Hans Gansch. In 2005 Jure received the Prešeren Prize for his performance of the Tomasi Trumpet Concerto with the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra. Jure has performed with many internationally renowned musicians including R.Tognetti, R.Galliano, S.Mead, R.Friedrich, S.Arnold...

In addition to performing classical repertoire, Jure enjoys playing contemporary music. From 2009-2011 Jure was a member of band for Balkan pop star Magnifico, who performs at the largest Slovenian music venues and regular tours across the Europe.



Andrea Corsini is Principal Horn of the Orchestra Filarmonica della Fenice in Venice since 1998. Graduated in 1985 at the Conservatory Giuseppe Verdi in Milan with professor Elvio Modonesi he specialized with Radovan Vlatkovic, taking part at the courses of the School of Music in Stuttgart. Under his guidance Maestro Corsini obtained a diploma of merit at Chigiana Academy of Siena in 1994.

An active orchestral performer, Maestro Corsini has performed with the Orchestra Camerata Salzburg, the Orchestra OSI Lugano, the Human Rights Orchestra based in Lucerne, the Philharmonic Orchestra of the Teatro alla Scala in Milan, the Orchestra of the Teatro Comunale di Bologna, and Orchestra I solisti Veneti. As a soloist, he has collaborated with the Theatre des Variétés of Monte Carlo, the Chamber Orchestra of Belluno, the Orchestra of the Teatro Stabile di Bergamo, and the prestigious instrumental group Achille Berruti in Milan. In 1995 he won the international competition as first horn soloist at the Orchestre Philharmonique de Monte Carlo, holding the position until 1998. He was horn section teacher of Corsi internazionali di perfezionamento musicale in Spilimbergo (Italy) from 1999 to 2018. Since 2015 he is horn teacher of the Asyan Youth Orchestra in Hong Kong.






After completing his education at the Conservatory Maribor's Artistic Gymnasium, **Nejc Merc** continued his studies at the Academy of Music in Ljubljana. In 2014, he graduated with honors and special commendation (Summa Cum Laude diploma) under the tutelage of Professor Darko Rošker. During his studies, he participated in several solo and chamber competitions, both national and international, achieving outstanding results.

As a soloist, he has performed with the Academy of Music Orchestra in Ljubljana, Brass Band Slovenia, Brassimo Brass Ensemble, Stadkapelle Deutschlandsberg, and other orchestras in Slovenia, Austria, and Croatia. He regularly collaborates with the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra, occasionally with the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra, the Slovenian Philharmonic Brass Ensemble and the Orchestra of the Conservatory of Music and Ballet Maribor. As a student, he also collaborated with the Symphony Orchestra and Big Band of the Academy of Music in Ljubljana. He is a member of the AGIS Euphonium Quartet and the Brassimo Brass Ensemble.

He conducts summer schools, seminars, solo concerts, and performances with various chamber groups both domestically and internationally. Additionally, he serves as a jury member and assists in preparing propositions for various international competitions. As a studio musician, he records and participates in genre-diverse projects (with over 20 recorded albums and three vinyl records). In 2021, he released his first solo audio album titled "Mercphonium."

Nejc plays the Besson Prestige Euphonium. Together with internationally renowned brass instrument manufacturers Lechner, he developed and plays his own Bellfront Baritone model, the Fritz.

He is a recipient of the Student Prešeren Award. Since 2013, he has been employed at the Conservatory of Music and Ballet in Maribor, where he directs the GŠ Center wind orchestra. Since 2017, he has also been teaching at the Academy of Music in Ljubljana. His students have achieved exceptional results in national and international competitions, passed entrance exams at various prestigious universities across Europe, and successfully auditioned for the wind orchestras of the Slovenian Armed Forces and Slovenian Police.

WOODWINDS





Karolina Šanti Zupan graduated and completed her specialist flute studies in the class of prof. Fedja Rupel at the Academy of Music in Ljubljana. She continued her art education at the College of Fine Arts in Vienna with prof. Wolfgang Schulz and completed it with honours. In addition, she attended masterclasses with James Galway, Irena Grafenauer, Suzan Milan, Peter Lucas Graf and other world-renowned flautists. Already during her studies at the Ljubljana Academy of Music, she was a laureate of numerous national and international competitions and in 1990, the recipient of the student Prešeren award.

Her professional artistic career began in 1991 in the orchestra of the Slovenian Philharmonic. She also worked as a solo flutist in the SNG Opera and Ballet Ljubljana orchestra. Since 2001, she has been a member of the international flute quartet 4Syrinx, with which she has been creating an independent series of concerts in the Vatroslav Lisinski Hall in Zagreb for many years. The 4Syrinx quartet, received the Porin discography of the year award in 2014. As a member of other chamber ensembles, which consist of renowned Slovenian and foreign artists, she actively performs in a wider international space.

She records wide range of flute literature for Slovenian and foreign radio stations. So far, she has released nine CDs, including two for flute and piano, two for flute and harp (Nocturno and Impresija), three with the 4Syrinx flute quartet (Decade, Monochromia and Room for Four), a concert for flute CD with the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra (Ibert, Feld and Reinecke) and in 2017 a CD for flute and orchestra. She is the author of instructional materials for learning the flute, published under the titles Skladbe za fluta 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6. Since the first edition in 2006, individual volumes of Skladbe za fluta have been reprinted several times.

Karolina Šanti Zupan joined the Academy of Music of the University of Ljubljana in 1995 and was elected full-time professor in 2008. From 2009 to 2021, she was the head of the wind, brass, and percussion department. She has been vice-dean for scientific and artistic research since 2022. Her success in the academic field is evidenced by numerous international and national awards received by her students. She also regularly cooperates with foreign educational institutions. Her last project collaboration was in Australia at the University of Melbourne. She regularly leads international seminars in Slovenia and abroad and is a member of expert juries at international competitions. She is a Yamaha Flute Artist.

Within the scientific field, Karolina's research is focused on interaction between artistic and pedagogical teaching and musical interpretation at the university-level of education. In 2019, she received a doctorate for doctoral dissertation titled Interaction between artistic and pedagogical education of future teachers of wind instruments.



Clarinetist and pedagogue **Jože Kotar** lives and works in Ljubljana, where for 12 years he served as principal clarinet of the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra. Currently he holds the same position with the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra. He is tenured professor of clarinet at the Academy of Music and also teaches at the Conservatory for Music and Ballet, both in the Slovenian capital.

He regularly performs in Slovenia and throughout Europe, the United States and South America as a soloist, chamber musician and a member of various ensembles. He has led master classes for clarinet and chamber music in Croatia, Serbia, Italy, Hungary, Belgium, Israel, Ireland, Canada, USA, Australia and Brazil, is frequently a member of juries at international competitions and is a regular guest at Slovenian and foreign festivals. He has performed and recorded as a soloist with many orchestras, led by conductors such as Marko Letonja, George Pehlivanian, Roger Boutry, Tetsui Honna, David Itkin, Benoît Fromanger, David de Villiers and others.

He has given the world premieres, both as a soloist and as a member of numerous chamber ensembles, of more than 190 works by many composers both Slovenian and foreign. As principal clarinet he performed with many famous conductors, such as Carlos Kleiber, Ricardo Mutti, Serge Baudo, Yurij Simonov, Hartmut Haenchen, Milan Horvat, Pavel Kogan, Zoltan Kocsis, Leopold Hager, En Shao...

He is a member, co-founder and artistic director of the Slovenian Clarinet Orchestra and the Slovenian Clarinet Sextet, and is also a member many other ensembles including the Ariart Woodwind Quintet (with whom he received the Bettetova Prize in 2007), the Woodwind Trio of the Slovenian Philharmonic and the contemporary music ensemble MD7, with whom he received the first Lipovšek Prize in 2013. Since 2007 he has been the conductor and artistic director of the Trbovlje Workers Wind Orchestra.

He has recorded numerous compact discs, including eight solo albums (with the Slovenian Philharmonic String Quartet, harpist Nicoletta Sanzin Fabri, the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra and the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra and four with pianist Luca Ferrini) and many discs with ensembles, including the Ariart Wind Quintet, the ensemble MD7, the Slovenian Clarinet Quartet, the Slovenian Clarinet Sextet and the Slovenian Philharmonic Wind Trio. He has twice recorded the Rossini Introduzione, tema e variazioni, first with the Slovenian Police Orchestra and another with the Trbovlje Workers Wind Orchestra in a live concert in the Netherlands.



Filip Orlović is a promising young musician, passionately engaged as a soloist, chamber musician and pedagogue. He completed his bachelor studies in Novi Sad in 2017 under the guidance of professors Gordan Tudor and Bunford Gabor. Subsequently, in 2019, he earned the title of Master of Arts at the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad (Serbia) under the guidance of Prof. Nikola Fabijanić. Filip also successfully completed his master's studies at the Academy of Music and Dance in Cologne (Germany), under the mentorship of Prof. Daniel Gauthier.

Throughout his career, Filip has reached significant milestones. In 2013, he was invited as a guest soloist for the »Music for Peace« program, performing chamber and solo pieces with piano and orchestras in Moscow and Tambov (Russia). In between he has performed with different ensembles and orchestras, including a notable solo performance with the Symphony Orchestra of Radio Television of Serbia (RTS) at the Kolarac Hall in Belgrade in 2024. As a member of the saxophone quartet »Eternum«, Filip completed his master's studies in chamber music in 2022 under the guidance of professors Georg Klütsch and Han-An Liu. The quartet recorded their debut CD titled »Voyages« in the same year, released by the label »Genuin« from Leipzig, Germany.

Filip has won numerous awards in international competitions and has performed in many prestigious orchestras and festivals both nationally and internationally. Recently, in 2024, he was appointed as professor of saxophone at the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad, Serbia.






Matej Šarc, born in 1965 in Ljubljana, began his oboe studies with Božo Rogelj at the Academy of Music in Ljubljana, and then furthered his education with Heinz Holliger at the Hochschule für Musik in Freiburg, Germany.

He was the first oboist of the Slovenian Radio and Television Symphony Orchestra and the Freiburg Philharmonic Orchestra. As a soloist and chamber musician, he has performed concerts throughout Europe, Australia, China, Mongolia, Japan, and both Americas. He has recorded numerous chamber and solo works for the oboe for several European radio stations. His recordings have been released by Slovenian and international record labels.

Since 1994, he has been a member of the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra and the Slowind Wind Quintet, with which he has received the Prešeren Fund Award, among other accolades. He teaches oboe at the Academy of Music in Ljubljana, the Conservatory of Music and Ballet in Ljubljana, and at master classes both domestically and internationally.

For twenty years, he dedicated himself to organizing and performing in the chamber music concert series Festival Slowind in Ljubljana, where he performed with members of the eponymous wind quintet and distinguished artists such as Alexander Lonquich, Christiane Iven, Heinz Holliger, Arvid Engegård, Robert Aitken, Ursula Oppens, Matthias Pintscher, Naoko Yoshino, and others.

Contemporary music holds a special place in his artistic activities. He has premiered numerous works by Slovenian and foreign composers and later turned his attention to Baroque music and its role in modern times.





Mihael Mitev is a Slovenian bassoonist. He started his musical education at the early age with his father Zoran Mitev, with whom he later studied in conservatorium and Academy of music in Ljubljana where he finished his bachelor studies. During bachelor studies, he spent a semester studying in Vienna at MDW with Richard Galler. After Mihael finished his bachelor studies, he continued his education at Zürcher Hochschule der Künste with Giorgio Madolesi, where he finished master studies. He attended masterclasses with professors such as: Andrea Zucco, Bence Boganyi, Robert Gillinger, Gustavo Nunez, Stefano Canuti, Pedro Silva ect. Currently he is a solo bassoon in Slovene National Theatre Maribor.

During his musical career Mihael was very successfully attending national and international competitions, latest being the ARD music competition 2019 in Munich where he reached the second round of the competition. On national competition TEMSIG he was the prize for best interpretation of Slovenian work in 2015 in woodwind quintet and 2016 as a soloist.

Mihael is a guest player in orchestras such as: Orchestre de Paris, Kammerorchester Basel, Musikkolegium Winterthur, Slovenian Philharmonic ect. This led him to play in biggest festivals in Europe with conductors like: Daniel Harding, Charles Dutoit, Jonathan Nott, Heinz Holliger etc.. In last year he is playing in Frankfurt Opera and Museums Orchestra (Frankfurt Opera). During his student years also played in youth orchestras such as: Gustav Mahler Jugendorchester, European Union Youth Orchestra, Zermatt festival Orchestra.
